

Audax Australia Brevet Permanent Rules

1. The Audax Australia Ride Rules, as amended from time to time, apply to Brevet Permanent events (Permanents) subject to the variations set out in these rules.
2. Temporary membership is not available for riders participating in Permanents.
3. To enter a Permanent a rider must forward a correctly completed entry form and correct payment to the ride organiser. The entry form must be received by the ride organiser not less than one week prior to the ride date. Ride organisers may stipulate a greater notice period at their discretion.
4. It is the rider's responsibility to determine and comply with lighting requirements as specified in Audax Australia Ride Rules. Based on the rider's start time, if any part of the maximum permitted time¹ for the ride is at night, the rider must comply with Audax Australia Ride Rule 7.
5. Routes are defined for each Permanent. Riders who leave the route to detour around hazardous road conditions or because of environmental conditions (such as flood or fire), must return to the route as soon as practicable. If riders leave the route for reasons other than hazardous or environmental conditions, they must return to the route at the same point before continuing.
6. Riders must carry their brevet card at all times and have it stamped or signed at the controls specified on the brevet card.
7. To have the successful completion of a Permanent recognised, the completed brevet card must be returned to the ride organiser within 7 days of the completion date.
8. The decision of Audax Australia is final in determining successful completion of a Permanent.
